
EXTENSION BIOLOGY*(SUBJECT CO ORDINATOR – Mr Colin Noy)***(The Biology Authority Course plus University of Queensland Study Units)**

Extension Biology is offered to students who have the desire and ability to operate at a higher academic level. Students have the opportunity to undertake the coursework and practical work towards completion of BL1011 – Genetics and Evolution, a first year course at the University of Queensland. Successful completion of the practical work and the examination will give students automatic credit (12 credit points) when they enrol in an appropriate course at the University of Queensland.

Much of the coursework is already included in our Authority course and students will be taught the extra subject matter over a period of two years. Students will have the opportunity to attend several practical sessions at the University.

Students considering Extension Biology need to be self-motivated and capable of working without close supervision. A strong academic record is an essential entry requirement.

Students will be required to purchase the university level text in addition to their normal texts. The University of Queensland charges a service fee for the course. This entitles students to a student number, a student card and library borrowing rights.
