Brisbane Boys' College understands that diversity and strength of character is vital for the continued success of the school. The Old Collegians' Bursary was established to provide an opportunity for a deserving son or grandson of an Old Boy, to attend BBC and experience all of its educational and co-curricular offerings.

The Old Collegians' Bursary is available to existing students and those not yet enrolled at the College, who are facing financial hardship or difficult circumstances.

### **Selection Criteria (to be addressed on the following pages)**

Boys eligible for the bursary are expected to demonstrate the following characteristics and qualities:

- Possess a willingness and desire to participate in a wide range of activities including those of an academic, sporting and cultural nature
- Show a commitment to hard work and teamwork
- Possess a strong and wholehearted personality
- Demonstrate honesty and integrity
- Demonstrate a desire to engage and achieve to their individual academic potential
- Provide evidence of a direct relationship with a BBC Old Boy as a son or grandson

### **Expectations**

The Old Collegians' Bursary is awarded to a boy who has potential to gain the most from a Brisbane Boys' College education and who will add to the fabric and history of the College by immersing themselves in the opportunities presented. The bursary is not limited to students who are necessarily considered gifted or the best in any given subject/activity. Furthermore, the recipient should demonstrate values and qualities synonymous with BBC, positively influencing his peers. All recipients are expected to maintain academic progress commensurate with their ability and to contribute fully and constructively to the life of the School in the areas of their interests, aptitudes and abilities. Bursary recipients will be subject to an annual review in relation to the stated selection criteria and expectations.

### **Remission**

The Old Collegians' Bursary will provide partial remission of Boarding/tuition fees for the duration of their schooling. Parents/Guardians will be required to cover all other expenses.

### **Process**

All applications will be reviewed by the Old Collegians Bursary Committee, being the OCA President, Director of Alumni and Community and the Headmaster or his delegate. Successful and unsuccessful candidates will be notified at the earliest opportunity.

### **Applications**

Old Collegians' Bursary applications should contain the following information:

- Completed *Application for Old Collegians' Bursary* booklet (on the following pages)
- A copy of your son's birth certificate or passport photo page
- School reports for the last two semesters
- Most recent NAPLAN results (if applicable)
- Up to two (2) A4 pages addressing the abovementioned Selection Criteria
- In accordance with PMSA Scholarships, Bursaries and Fee Discount Policy, financial hardship or need is a selection criterion for any bursary. Therefore short-listed applicants will be asked to provide evidence of financial hardship.

*The closing date is listed on the Brisbane Boys' College website, under Scholarships, for Old Collegians' Bursary.*

Please note Old Collegians' Bursary applicants are **only required to complete this Application for Old Collegians' Bursary booklet** and do not have to complete the separate *Application for Scholarship* booklet as well.
