

ROBOTICS WORKSHOP

BBC is offering a two day holiday Robotics Workshop over the Term 4 break for boys and girls in Years 4 to 7. Students of all abilities are encouraged to attend.

The Workshops focus on building STEM skills (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) through the use of LEGO EV3 kits.
