



BBC Bus Service Conditions for Parents and Students

Term Bus Pass Holders

Students travelling on the BBC chartered bus service must be registered and hold a valid BBC Term bus pass before travelling. Parents are invited via email and the school's newsletters, to register their son/s at the beginning of each term.

Your son will not be required to carry or present the Term Pass when boarding the bus, however he must carry his BBC ID card, in the event that proof of identification is required by the Bus Driver.

20 Trip Bus Pass Holders

Students travelling on the BBC chartered bus service must be registered and hold a valid BBC 20 Trip Bus Pass before travelling. Parents are invited via email and the school's newsletters, to register their son/s at the beginning of each term.

Should your son travel without having his pass, he must present his 20 Trip Bus Pass to Main Reception in the Main Administration building by the following week (except for the last week of term, where all outstanding trips must be paid by the last day of term).

Any outstanding trips that have not been deducted from the 20 Trip Pass, or where a pass has not been purchased, will be charged to your fee account at the end of each term, at the rate of \$7.75 per outstanding trip, plus a \$50 Administration Fee.

All Bus Pass Holders

Students travelling on the BBC chartered bus service must be registered and hold a valid BBC bus pass before travelling. Parents are invited via email and the school newsletters to register their son/s at the beginning of each term.

As a representative of Brisbane Boys' College, students are expected to behave appropriately and according to Brisbane Boys' College acceptable behaviour and policy.

It is the student's responsibility to be aware of his bus route number and his collection/drop off bus stop/s.

Students must ensure they are at the correct registered bus stop at least five minutes prior to timetabled departure time. If the registered bus stop does not have a time specified, it is recommended that he be at the bus stop at the time specified for the previous stop.

Timings and pick up points may change from term to term, depending on the needs of travellers. If this is the case, parents will be notified via email and the school newsletters at the beginning of each term.

Students must hail the bus in the morning to alert the driver that they intend to travel on the bus. In the afternoons, the BBC chartered buses are parked along Miskin Street (outside Miskin Oval) and leave promptly at 3.20pm.

Students must be collected and dropped off to their registered bus stop by Brisbane Bus Lines, unless authorised by the College.

Use of the BBC chartered bus service results in the agreement to the above conditions.
