This position requires that you hold registration, or are eligible for registration, as a teacher in Queensland.

You will be required to:

- Apply creative and innovative approaches to teaching and learning utilising information technology as a tool to leverage learning.
- Assess and report constructively on student learning.
- Support personal development and participation in society.
- Create and maintain safe and supportive learning environments, particularly in relation to behaviour management, aimed at building positive and authentic relationships with students.
- Foster productive relationships with students, families, staff, and the community.
- Be actively involved in the College's Co-curricular program.
- Be actively involved in the College's Wellbeing program.
- Commit to reflective practice and ongoing professional renewal.
- Be actively engaged and be willing to contribute and collaborate within a team environment.
- Be positive in support of the College's traditions and Christian ethos.
- Maintain such records as may be required by the College.
