### **Teaching Duties**

- Exhibit experience and discernment in teaching and assessing Guitar performance, with a knowledge of contemporary teaching and pedagogy.
- Be aware of appropriate repertoire that promotes holistic and enthusiastic learning.
- Prepare students and student bands to participate in performances.
- Provide a written report of each student at the end of each semester.
- Liaise with parents when required.
- Assist in organising, supervising and attending concerts that involve Guitar/Band students held at the College.
- Work collaboratively with the Head of Performance Music to further develop Guitar teaching and playing at Brisbane Boys' College.
- Assist the Head of Performance Music in the maintenance and purchasing of College Rock Band Equipment.
- Monitor and encourage student attendance at rehearsals and concerts.

### **Other Required Experience – Song Writing and Production**

- Experience in song writing with the ability to teach the skill of song writing.
- Experience and knowledge of how to record Rock Bands in a studio setting.
- Experience and knowledge of the production (pre/post) requirements of recording a Rock Band.

**Contact Time:** 2 days per week, term-time. Some school holiday work may also be involved.
