Parents

- Encourage the processes for success – goal setting, play within the rules, honest effort, skilled performance, tactical awareness, and team loyalty

Spectators

- No verbal or equipment abuse or provocation of others
- Respect others

- Take notice of the opinion of your coach / manager / mentor
- Be properly attired:
 - wear the correct uniform and wear it properly
 - keep your clothes and equipment clean and tidy
 - having committed to an activity, remain committed to it for the duration of the season

Officials

- Administer the activity in accordance with the rules of participation and without bias
- Communicate clearly with the participants so that they understand your decisions
- Respect the participants and their supporters
